



Lovely scenery, birds singing, just drop it onto the green and tap in the putt.

The green slopes right to left and both bunkers are well patronised. 10th _{137 m} Par 3 Black tee: 137 m Blue tee: 130 m White tee: 120 m Red tee: 130m Only 137 m but plenty to consider when playing the 10th.

Front bunkers are magnetic but hitting long will leave you a sometimes unstoppable downhill putt

11th Par 5 Black tee: 513 m Blue tee: 508 m White tee: 467 m Red tee: 467m A downhill tee shot puts the average 200 m player within range of the fairway bunker where an island garden awaits. Prudent play is to lay up short leaving 130m in. Avoid going over the back. Not nice





to the scorecard.

14th Par 4

Black tee: 348 m

Blue tee: 343 m

White tee: 290 m

Red tee: 290m 200 m -

Not hooker friendly. A deep drain one metre from the out-of-bounds fence fixes them.

Accuracy needed on approach shot. Hazard and bank on left, bunker right. Otherwise

enjoy.

15th 181 m Par 3 Black tee: 181m Blue tee: 173m White tee: 155m Red tee: 140m Prettiest hole on the course. Long par three with hidden bunker left. Hitting into mounded gardens is not recommended. The green is large with gentle

slope to front.
